Navigating carbon markets under Article 6 of the Paris Agreement can be complex. **The CACE A6 Country Readiness Tracker on Emsurge** brings clarity — helping governments, investors, buyers and project developers assess national readiness and feasibility of carbon opportunities at a glance.

We take a deep-dive into the countries advancing the fastest with Article 6 compliance.

WHAT IT DOES

The Tracker evaluates a country's preparedness to generate or host highintegrity carbon credits under Article 6 or CORSIA.

- Measures progress across regulatory, technical, and institutional readiness
- + Helps buyers identify credible host countries for the export of A6 carbon credits
- + Flags gaps and opportunities for capacity building and investment
- + Provides a one stop shop for information on which countries have frameworks, the LoAs with Initial Reports exist, and which countries are most likely to deliver CORSIA eligible credits
- Integrated with the CACE ITMO auction platform, providing participants with confidence in the credits they buy






WHY THE A6 TRACKER?

- + Governments Benchmark readiness, strengthen frameworks
- + Developers Identify promising host countries and reduce risks
- + Investors & Buyers Prioritise low risk markets with transparency & integrity
- + Researchers & Think Tanks Inform analysis and policy

EXAMPLE INDICATORS

- + Has the country submitted its first Biennial Transparency Report?
- + Has it developed an official Article 6 Framework? Is it aligned with UNFCCC requirements for Article 6 participation?
- Are Letters of Authorisation (LoAs) being issued?
- Is there a registry in place to prevent double counting?
- Does the country have a Designated National Authority and the legal and technical capacity to authorise corresponding adjustments?
